



Modern Slavery Policy

At Lavastar, we believe that Modern Slavery in all its forms constitutes a detestable abuse of human rights. We acknowledge that business has a significant role to play in combating modern slavery, both domestically and internationally. Lavastar is committed to maintaining a culture where slavery, servitude, compulsory labour or human trafficking is quite simply, unacceptable.

Every member of staff has a role to play in combating this crime, by remaining alert to the risk of slavery, however small it may be, within our business and within our supply chain. This statement is issued pursuant to section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

What are we doing to tackle modern slavery? To demonstrate our commitment to tackling modern slavery, Lavastar will:

1. Conduct appropriate due diligence on our sub-contractors and suppliers, in relation to their modern slavery measures.
2. Maintain a robust recruitment and checking procedure, to ensure that all employees of Lavastar are appropriately vetted.
3. Conduct a risk assessment of our business internally to identify areas of vulnerability.
4. Encourage staff to report concerns and protect reporters of wrong doing directly to their line managers whilst maintaining confidentiality and discretion.
